ADISA Certification, which provides independent, globally recognized accreditation for various companies offering IT Asset Disposal and secure data erasure services.



Blackbelt360's data erasure conforms to the requirements of NIST Special Publication 800-88, verified through ADISA testing.



Achieving ISO 27001 ISM means that devices processed using Blackbelt360 software adhere to the highest standards of data security, risk management, and compliance.

## Compliance with industry erasure standards

NAID AAA (i-SIGMA), R2v3 (SERI) and e-Stewards set the data sanitization requirements that certified refurbishers, recyclers and ITAD operators must meet. Blackbelt360's data erasure meets these requirements, so certified organizations can use Blackbelt360 to satisfy the data sanitization element of their certification.



R2v3 is SERI's global certification standard for the ITAD industry. Blackbelt360's data erasure meets the data sanitization requirements of R2v3, supporting certified operators' compliance.



NAID AAA is i-SIGMA's certification for secure data destruction service providers. Blackbelt360's data erasure meets the requirements NAID AAA-certified operators must satisfy.



e-Stewards is the certification standard for responsible electronics recyclers. Blackbelt360's data erasure meets the data sanitization requirements e-Stewards-certified operators must meet.
